COMMENTS

Auction offerings declined further and totalled 5.0 M/Kgs this week. There was good general demand.

Ex-Estate offerings declined fairly sharply and totalled 0.6 M/Kgs. Improved demand for the BOPF's, whilst the BOP's with the exception of the Best available met with less demand.

Best Western BOP/BOPF's were firm and up to Rs. 50 per kg dearer selectively following special inquiry, whilst the others were irregular. In the Below Best category - BOP's, where quality was maintained, were barely steady, whilst the others were irregular and often easier. Corresponding BOPF's were firm and up to Rs. 50-100 per kg dearer for select coloury sorts. At the lower end, BOP's were irregular and often easier, whilst the corresponding BOPF's were firm and irregularly dearer by up to Rs. 50 per kg. Nuwara Eliya BOP's were mostly unsold, whilst the corresponding BOPF's sold around last week's levels. Uda Pussellawa - Better BOP/BOPF's were irregularly easier by up to Rs. 50 per kg, whilst the others were irregular and barely steady. Uva - Seasonal teas were easier. Other BOP's were sharply lower, whilst the corresponding BOPF's sold around last week's levels.

High & Mid Grown CTC - BP1's were irregular, whilst the PF1's sold around last week's levels. Corresponding Low Grown types - PF1's which commenced firm and up to Rs. 50 per kg dearer, appreciated by a further Rs. 100 per kg as the sale progressed.

Low Growns comprised of 2.2 M/Kgs. Leafy and Semi-Leafy teas met with fair demand, whilst the Small Leaf varieties met with less demand and were easier.

In the Leafy catalogues, well-made OP1's were firm on last, whilst the balance were firm to dearer. Select Best and Best BOP1's sold at last levels, whilst the others declined. Well-made OP/OPA's were easier, whilst the Below Best and teas at the bottom were fully firm. PEK's in general were firm, whilst the PEK1's eased.

In the Tippy catalogues, well-made FBOP's together with the bolder varieties in the Below Best category were easier, whilst the balance sold around last levels. Select Best FF1's were easier, whilst the Best and Below Best declined sharply. Teas at the bottom were firm.

In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas continued to attract good demand and were firm, whilst the Best and Below Best too followed a similar trend. However, the leafier varieties were firm to selectively dearer.

Nuwara Eliya's were mostly unsold. Uda Pussellawa's - Better teas were irregularly easier, whilst the others were barely steady. Uva's - Seasonal teas were limited on offer and were irregular and easier, whilst the others were sharply lower.

BOPF

Best Western's, where quality was maintained, were firm and selectively dearer following special inquiry. Teas in the Below Best category were firm and up to Rs. 50 per kg dearer for select clean leaf coloury sorts, whilst teas at the lower end were firm and irregularly dearer. Nuwara Eliya's sold around last. Uda Pussellawa's - Better teas were Rs. 20-40 per kg easier, whilst the others were barely steady. Uva's - Seasonal teas were limited on offer and prices were irregular, whilst the others sold around last week's levels.

OP/OPA

Well-made OP/OPA's were firm to easier by Rs. 50 per kg, whilst the others at the lower end were firm to dearer by Rs. 50 per kg.

PEKOE/PEKOE1

A limited selection of flavoury PEK's that were available were irregularly easier. Orthodox Leafy PEK/PEK1's, in general, were firm on last. Best Rotovane PEK's sold at firm to irregular rates.

FBOP/FBOPF1

A limited selection of flavoury FBOPs that were available were irregularly easier. Well-made Orthodox Leafy FBOP/FF1's together with the clean leaf Below Best sorts were easier by Rs. 50-100 per kg and more at times, whilst the others at the lower end were irregular.

The poorer sorts declined by Rs. 30-40 per kg following quality.
