QUALITY

*A selection of Westerns were improved, whilst the Nuwara Eliya's together with the Uva/Uda Pussellawa's were irregular and barely maintained. Low Grown's were lower to last.*

COMMENTS

*A total of 7 M/Kgs were on offer this week, of which, approximately 1 M/Kgs comprise of Ex-Estate teas. There was good demand.*

*Ex-Estate offerings showed an improvement in quality, particularly for teas from the Western slopes. Consequently, select pre-quality season invoices appreciated in value, at times, substantially following quality/special inquiry and that too, primarily for the BOP invoices. In the Below Best category too, select brighter invoices were readily absorbed at firm to dearer rates, with price gains of Rs. 20-30 per kg being realised for these improved teas. At the lower end of the market, teas were firm and dearer to a lesser extent. Nuwara Eliya's were irregular and mostly easier, whilst teas from the Uva/Uda Pussellawa regions were mostly irregular and barely steady, with a few select clean leaf teas appreciating in value.*

*CTC teas continued to sell around the previous week's levels, whilst prices tend to fluctuate following quality.*

*Auction offerings begin to show a decline from next week's auction (Sale No. 6), whilst the quality of offerings particularly from the Western slopes show a gradual improvement with a wider selection of seasonal teas on offer.*

*Low Grownns comprised of 3.1 M/Kgs. There was fair demand in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues.*

*BOP1/OP1's, in general, were easier. A selection of better OP/OPA's maintained, whilst the balance were lower. Teas at the bottom were fully firm. A selection of well-made PEK's maintained, whilst all others declined substantially. PEK1's in general were firm.*

*In the Tippy catalogues, Select Best and Best FBOP/FF1's declined. However, cleaner Below Best and teas at the bottom sold around last levels, whilst the balance were irregular following quality.*

*In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas continued to attract good demand and were fully firm. Best were firm to selectively dearer, whilst the balance were irregular following quality.*

NATIONAL TEA SALE AVERAGES - JANUARY 2021

***All elevations show an increase YOY in LKR and USD terms.***

*National average for the month of January 2021 of Rs. 645.02 (USD 3.40) has shown an increase of Rs. 56.17 vis-à-vis Rs. 588.85 (USD 3.28) of January 2020. However, shows a marginal gain of Rs. 0.95 vis-à-vis Rs. 644.07 (USD 3.47) of December 2020.*

*When analysing the respective elevational averages, High Grownns, totalling Rs. 613.29 (USD 3.23), have shown a significant gain of Rs. 77.43 vis-à-vis Rs. 535.86 (USD 2.98) of January 2020. However, shows a decrease of Rs. 23.47 when compared to the December 2020 average of Rs. 636.76 (USD 3.43). Medium Grownns, totalling Rs. 585.37 (USD 3.09) for January 2021, have shown a substantial increase of Rs. 90.75 vis-à-vis Rs. 494.62 (USD 2.75) of January 2020, whilst showing a marginal decline of Rs. 4.22 when compared to the December 2020 average of Rs. 589.59 (USD 3.17). Meanwhile, Low Grownns, totalling Rs. 673.04 (USD 3.55), have shown an increase of Rs. 44.30 vis-à-vis Rs. 628.74 (USD 3.50) of January 2020. In the case of Low Grownns, a gain of Rs. 11.27 is recorded vis-à-vis Rs. 661.77 (USD 3.56) of December 2020.*

**SALE OF - 1ST FEBRUARY 2021 (SALE NO. 36)**

CTC LEAF: 31,084 packages of Current Season and 50 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with quite a strong demand.

BROKENS: Good Brokens particularly the brighter Invoices attracted strong competition and were fully firm to occasionally dearer. All others met with a good demand and were mostly steady. Plainer and BLF types were a little easier with some withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Best Fannings continued to meet with a strong demand and were mostly dearer. Good and Mediums were about firm. All others followed quality.

CTC DUST: 8,640 packages of Current Season teas and 50 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring Dusts particularly CDs were easier by Tk.10/- to Tk.12/-, closely following quality. Their Mediums continued to sell at firm to slightly dearer levels. Plain and BLF Dusts met with less demand and sold around last levels with quite fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Market met with a similar trend as last whereby bright Invoices sold at mostly dearer rates whilst good and Medium varieties were about steady. Blenders lent a useful support with some interest from the Loose tea buyers. Dusts were an easier market.
