QUALITY

Westerns together with the Nuwara Eliyas/Uda Pussellawas were barely maintained. A select small range of seasonal Uvas were on offer, whilst the others too were brighter to last. Low Growns were lower to last.

COMMENTS

Auction offerings were fairly similar to last and totalled 6.7 M/Kgs. Overall, a bearish sentiment with only the well-made teas attracting spontaneous demand.

Ex-Estate offerings showed a decline on last and totalled approximately 0.9 M/Kgs, marginally behind the 0.95 M/Kgs the previous week. Quality of teas from the Western, Nuwara Eliya and Uda Pusselllawa planting districts showed no significant change with a greater weight of the offerings comprising of a fair average quality.

Best Western BOP's declined substantially by Rs. 50-80 per kg and more, whilst the others were irregular and easier. Corresponding BOPF's - Few select invoices appreciated substantially following quality/special inquiry, whilst the others were irregular. In the Below Best category, particularly the BOP's plunged by Rs. 50 per kg and more with many invoices remaining unsold due to a lack of any suitable bids. Corresponding BOPF's declined by Rs. 20 per kg and more. At the lower end, Plainer BOP's declined Rs. 20 per kg and more, and here again, with many withdrawals. Corresponding BOPF's were firm and Rs. 10-20 per kg lower. Nuwara Eliyas' continued to be irregular following quality, whilst the Uda Pussellawas' showed no change in its price structure with a majority of the teas selling at the lower end of the market.

Seasonal Uvas' were on offer for the second week, which met with excellent demand and most teas were readily absorbed at attractive prices ranging from Rs. 700 to Rs. 1,850 per kg for the BOP, BOPF and PEK grades. Non seasonal teas from the region too met with better demand and were often up to Rs. 20 per kg dearer with the exception of the poorly made types.

High and Mid Grown CTC teas continued to be a weak feature with no change in the overall price structure and continued to sell at the bottom end of the market. Corresponding Low Grown types met with improved demand, particularly as the sale progressed and gained Rs. 20-30 per kg on last week's levels.

The customary Uva quality season commenced early (in and around mid-July) following up with dry weather combined with the desiccating winds that blow in the region seems to have ended abruptly this year. Latest reports indicate the climate in the region to have changed early this week with scattered showers being experienced in some parts of the Uva Region. This would mean that we are unlikely to witness any seasonal teas from mid-September sales onwards.

Low Growns comprised of 2.8 M/Kgs in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues. Well-made teas continued to maintain, whilst the balance were irregularly easier following quality.

In the Leafy catalogues, Select Best BOP1/OP1's together with cleaner Below Best varieties were fully firm to dearer, whilst the others and poorer sorts were irregular. A range of better OP/OPA's maintained, whilst the others where quality was not maintained and the poorer sorts were barely steady. A few better PEK/PEK1's maintained, whilst the others and mixed varieties in particular were lower.

In the Tippy catalogues, well-made FBOP/FF1's sold around last levels. Few cleaner Below Best too were firm, whilst the balance were easier following quality.

In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas continued to attract good demand. Best and cleaner Below Best were firm to dearer, whilst the balance were irregular following quality.

INDIA

Benchmark of Quality Teas

Persisting difference between the small tea growers and the bought leaf factories in Assam over the PSF (Price Sharing Formula) and the MBP (Minimum Benchmark Prices) of green tea leaf does not augur well for the industry and needs a pragmatic approach to find a permanent solution.

As the small tea growers contribute to about 50 per cent total tea production in the State, fluctuation in the prices of green tea leaf has a direct bearing on the industry which cannot be ignored. Volatility of green lad prices leading to distress selling of green leaf has been overshadowing the success story of a silent economic revolution in the State scripted by the over one lakh first-generation Assamese entrepreneurs.

Nuwara Eliya's - Select invoices were dearer following quality, whilst the others were irregular. Uda Pussellawa's were barely steady and often irregular following quality. Uva's - Seasonal teas witnessed a buoyant market following quality, whilst the other brighter sorts were Rs. 10-20 per kg dearer.

BOPF

Best Western's - Select invoices were substantially dearer following quality/special inquiry, whilst the others were irregular. In the Below Best category, better teas were firm to marginally easier, whilst the others together with the Plainer sorts declined Rs. 10-20 per kg. Nuwara Eliya's were barely steady. Uda Pussellawa's were barely steady and irregular following quality. Uva's - Seasonal teas gained sharply, whilst the other brighter sorts were Rs. 10-20 per kg dearer.

OP/OPA

Well made OP/OPA's firm to dearer Rs. 10 per kg, whilst others were firm on last.

PEKOE/PEKOE1

A limited selection of Flavory PEK's that were available were irregularly easier. Well made Orthodox leafy PEK/PEK1's firm on last whilst others were irregularly dearer. Rotovane PEK's sold around last week's closing levels. Others were irregular and mostly lower.

FBOP/FBOPF1

A limited selection of Flavory FBOP's that were available, were irregularly easier. Well-made Orthodox FBOP's were firm on last whilst others were easier Rs. 10-20 per kg. FF1's in general were easier Rs. 10 - 20 per kg.

Best and Below Best Dust1's also increased by Rs. 15 - 25 per kg while secondary Dust1's declined by Rs. 20 - 30 per kg on invoices where there was a decline in quality.

Low Grown Dust1's were mainly firm to dearer by Rs. 10 - 20 per kg following improved demand whilst Low Grown CTC's also gained Rs. 10 -15 per kg or more at times specifically on selective invoices along with the High & Medium Grown CTC's which gained by Rs. 15 - 20 per kg following limited volume on offer however, secondary PD's and Dust1's saw a declined by Rs. 10 -15 per kg.

<u>DUST</u>

Clean Secondaries were firm to dearer by Rs. 05 - 10 per kg. Others declined by Rs. 25 - 35 per kg. Low Grown's followed a similar trend.
