QUALITY

Westerns were irregular. Nuwara Eliya's were lower to last. Uva/Uda Pussellawa's were irregular and barely maintained, whilst the Low Grown's were similar to last.

COMMENTS

Auction offerings totalled 6.7 M/Kgs.

Ex-Estate offerings comprised of approximately 1 M/Kgs. There was good demand.

Best Western BOP's, which commenced on a hesitant note, gained Rs. 20-40 per kg and more on select invoices particularly as the sale progressed, whilst the others were irregular following quality. Corresponding BOPF's followed a similar trend with select invoices gaining Rs. 30-50 per kg following special inquiry. Here again, others in the Best category were irregular as buyers followed quality closely picking up pre-seasonal quality teas of value. In the Below Best category, BOP's were barely steady, whilst the corresponding BOPF's were firm and up to Rs. 10 per kg lower. Teas at the lower end sold around last week's levels. Nuwara Eliyas were sharply lower following quality. Uda Pussellawa BOP/BOPF's mostly sold around last week's levels, whilst the Uvas were irregular.

High and Medium Grown CTC teas declined by Rs. 20-30 per kg, particularly for teas in the higher price bracket, whilst the Low Grown varieties - better teas sold around last. Others were irregular and easier with the poorest being difficult of sale.

Low Grown teas comprised of approximately 3.1 M/Kgs in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues. There was fair demand. BOP1/OP1's were in general lower. A selection of well-made OP/OPA's maintained, whilst the balance declined. However, teas at the bottom were fully firm. Barring a few well-made PEK/PEK1's, which were firm, all others were easier. In the Tippy catalogue, well-made FBOP's together with cleaner Below Best maintained. Others were irregularly lower. Well-made FF1's too were easier. However, the balance were fully firm. In the Premium catalogue high priced teas declined, whilst the balance sold around last levels.

Teas in the Below Best category were barely steady, whilst the Plainer sorts were firm. Nuwara Eliyas were easier following quality. Uda Pussellawas were firm. Uvas were barely steady and tend to fluctuate following quality.

BOPF

Best Westerns - Select invoices gained Rs. 30-50 per kg following special inquiry, whilst the others were irregular. Teas in the Below Best category were firm and Rs. 10 per kg lower, whilst the Plainer sorts continued to sell around last week's levels. Nuwara Eliyas declined up to Rs. 50 per kg. Uda Pussellawas continued to sell around last week's levels. Uvas were firm and Rs.10-20 per kg lower following quality.

OP/OPA

Well-made OP/OPA's firm whilst others gained Rs. 10-20 per kg.

PEKOE/PEKOE1

A limited selection of liquoring PEK's that were available were irregularly lower. Well made Orthodox leafy PEK/PEK1's were firm on last whilst others were firm to dearer. Well made Rotovane PEK's barely steady. Others were irregularly easier.

FBOP/FBOPF1

A limited selection of liquoring FBOPs that were available were irregularly easier. Orthodox Leafy FBOP/FF1's in general were firm to dearer.
