COMMENTS

The 40th sale of the year concluded today had on offer a total of 5.7 M/Kgs vis-à-vis a 6.0 M/Kgs on offer the previous week. There was good general demand.

Ex-Estate offerings totalled 0.75 M/Kgs and prices were often irregular following quality.

Best Western BOP's - Select high priced teas were irregular, whilst the others gained Rs. 20 per kg and more for select invoices. Corresponding BOPF's - Select high priced teas of last week were sharply lower, whilst the others were up to Rs. 20 per kg easier. In the Below Best category, a selection of improved BOP's gained Rs. 20 per kg and more, whilst the others were firm and easier. Corresponding BOPF's in the higher price bracket were firm and Rs. 10-20 per kg lower, whilst the others sold around last week's levels. At the lower end, BOP's were Rs. 10-20 per kg lower, whilst the corresponding BOPF's continued to sell around last week's levels. Nuwara Eliya BOP's were mostly firm, whilst the corresponding BOPF's were neglected and often unsold. Uda Pussellawas' sold around last week's levels. Uva BOP's were firm and Rs. 10-20 per kg lower, whilst the corresponding BOPF's sold around last week's levels.

High and Mid Grown CTC's - BP1's had hardly any offerings, whilst the PF1's were firm around last week's levels. Corresponding Low Grown types continued to sell well with the PF1 grade appreciating a Rs. 10-20 per kg on select invoices.

Neat well-made liquoring FNGS1's and primary Dust appreciated sharply particularly as the sale progressed - widening the gap further between the well-made types and their poorer counterparts.

Low Grown comprised of 2.4 M/Kgs in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues. Well-made teas together with cleaner secondaries met with good demand, whilst the others were firm.

In the Leafy catalogues, Select Best BOP1/OP1's were fully firm to selectively dearer, whilst all others maintained. Better OP/OPA's in general were fully firm to selectively dearer, whilst the cleaner Below Best varieties and poorer sorts maintained. Better PEK/PEK1's too met with fair demand, whilst the mixed varieties and poorer sorts in particular were irregular and mostly lower.

In the Tippy catalogues, well-made FBOP/FF1's were firm to dearer, whilst the cleaner secondaries and cleaner teas at the bottom appreciated. Balance sold around last levels.

In the Premium catalogues, Very Tippy teas continued to attract good demand. Best and cleaner Below Best appreciated, whilst the balance sold around last levels.

CROP AND WEATHER

For the period 04 - 10 October 2021

Western/Nuwara Eliya Regions

Overcast weather with occasional spells of bright weather was reported in the Western Region, whilst the Nuwara Eliya Region reported dull and rainy weather throughout the week. The Department of Meteorology expects sporadic showers in both regions and strong winds in the Nuwara Eliya Region in the week ahead.

Uva/Udapussellawa Region

The Udupussellawa Region reported dull weather with occasional showers mostly during the morning hours and spells of bright weather towards the evening hours.
