QUALITY

Westerns were irregular. Nuwara Eliyas' were improved. Uva/Uda Pussellawas showed no change, whilst the Low Growns were similar to last.

COMMENTS

Total Auction offerings were marginally higher to the previous week and totalled 5.0 M/Kgs. There was fair general demand.

Ex-Estate offerings too were marginally higher and totalled 0.70 M/Kgs.

Improved demand for select Best Westerns in the backdrop of its limited availability and consequently, price gains of Rs. 100-200 per kg for these seasonal teas. Other Westerns were firm and Rs. 50-100 per kg dearer. Nuwara Eliya BOP's were limited in volume and appreciated Rs. 200-300 per kg following quality, whilst there were hardly any corresponding BOPF invoices on offer. Teas from the Uda Pussellawa Region gained Rs. 100 per kg and more, whilst selling at the lower end of the market. Uva BOP's gained Rs. 100-150 per kg, whilst the corresponding BOPF's sold around last week's levels.

CTC teas continued to sell around its previous week's prices with a few select invoices gaining up to Rs. 50 per kg, particularly from the Mid Grown sector.

Low Growns comprised of 2.3 M/Kgs. Leafy catalogues met with fair demand, whilst the Semi-Leafy and Small Leaf varieties were easier. Shippers to Iran and Türkiye continued to be very selective, whilst shippers to Russia were fairly active.

In the Leafy & Semi Leafy catalogues, a selection of well-made OP1/BOP1's were firm to selectively dearer, whilst the balance were irregular and were mostly lower. OP/OPA's, in general, were firm. PEK/PEK1's too in general were easier.

In the Tippy catalogues, select Best FBOP's were easier. However, a few cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom met with fair demand, whilst the others were lower. Well-made FF1's declined, whilst a few cleaner Below Best sold around last levels. Balance were easier.

In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas together with the Best declined, whilst a few cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom sold around last levels. Balance were easier.

- * Tea Exports for the month of January 2023 totalled 17.56 M/Kgs, showing a decrease of 3.26 M/Kgs vis-à-vis 20.82 M/Kgs of January 2022.
- * Main categories of Bulk Tea, Packeted Tea and Tea Bags have shown a decrease when compared to the corresponding month of 2022.
- * FOB value of Rs. 2,055.34 records a significant increase of Rs. 1,107.10 compared to Rs. 948.24 of January 2022.
- * FOB value of USD 5.66 records an increase of 0.93 in comparison to USD 4.73 of January 2022. (Refer table below).

BOPF Best Western's - Select invoices gained Rs. 100 per kg and more following special inquiry,

whilst the others were irregular. In the Below Best category, select improved teas were Rs. 50-100 per kg dearer, whilst the others were irregular. Teas at the lower end were firm and up to Rs. 50 per kg dearer. Nuwara Eliya's had hardly any offerings. Uda Pussellawa's gained

Rs. 100 per kg and more for select clean leaf invoices. Uva's were generally firm.

OP/OPA Well-made OP/OPA's were firm on last, whilst teas at the lower end were irregularly dearer.

PEKOE/PEKOE1 A limited selection of Flavory PEK's that were available were irregularly dearer. Orthodox

leafy PEK/PEK1's in general were easier Rs. 50-100 per kg and more at times. Best Rotavane PEK's firmed and upto Rs. 50-100 per kg dearer. Others were irregular but mostly dearer.

Select Best Dust1's were firm to dearer by Rs. 50 per kg, whilst the Best and Below Best Dust1's were mostly firm. The poorer sorts were firm to dearer by Rs. 20-40 per kg. Best Low Grown varieties declined where price levels decreased by Rs. 40-60 per kg except for a few select invoices which were firm on last week's levels. Teas in the Below Best category were firm, whilst the poorer sorts were mostly firm to easier by Rs. 20-30 per kg.

Best High and Medium Grown CTCs were easier by Rs. 20-40 per kg. Below Best varieties and the poorer sorts were mostly firm. Best Low Grown CTC's declined by Rs. 70-100 per kg, whilst the Below Best varieties and the poorer sorts were firm to irregularly dearer.

DUST

Cleaner secondaries appreciated substantially by Rs. 70-100 and more at times, whilst the poorer sorts gained by Rs. 50-70 per kg. Best Low Grown varieties declined sharply, whilst the poorer sorts declined by Rs. 10-20 per kg.


