Quality

A selection of Western High Growns were improved, whilst teas from the Eastern slopes and Low Growns were fairly similar to last.

COMMENTS

Total auction offerings declined marginally and totalled 5.3 M/Kgs vis-à-vis a 5.5 M/Kgs on offer the previous week. Well-made teas in the High Growns appreciated, whilst Low Growns sold firm on last. The others witnessed price fluctuations primarily following qualitative aspects.

Ex-Estate offerings totalled 0.76 M/Kgs, marginally higher volume over the previous week. Quality of teas from the Western slopes were improved, whilst the others were similar to last.

Improved demand for a selection of Westerns in the Best and Below Best categories, for both BOP & BOPF grades where prices were dearer by Rs.50-100 per kg. The others in the Best and Below Best categories were irregular following quality. Prices at the lower end of the market continued to remain reasonably firm providing positive predictions for the future of tea prices..

High & Mid Grown CTC's and particularly the better teas often witnessed a similar trend in prices to last week, whilst the corresponding Low Grown varieties gained by Rs. 20-40 per kg.

Low Growns comprised of 2.25 M/Kgs. The Leafy category met with less demand, whilst the Semi-Leafy and Tippy categories met with fair demand.


In the Leafy and Semi-Leafy catalogues, Best BOP1's maintained, whilst the Below Best varieties and the clean leaf teas at the bottom declined. OP1's, in general, were easier. Well-made OPA's were fully firm, whilst the Below Best together with the clean leaf teas at the bottom declined. Well-made PEK's maintained. The Below Best varieties were easier. Clean leaf teas at the bottom were fully firm. PEK1's, in general, were easier.

In the Tippy catalogues, Select Best and Best FBOP's were firm on last, whilst the Below Best together with the teas at the bottom declined. The bolder varieties too followed a similar trend. Well-made FF1's were sold around last levels, whilst the others, in general, declined.

In the Premium catalogues, Few Select Best Tippy teas were firm to dearer, whilst the Best together with the Below Best varieties were irregular following quality.

Iraq has been ranked No. 01 amongst major importers of Ceylon Tea with a total of 14.67M/Kgs, an a marginal decline of 0.40% YoY in January-June 2024 against the previous year's 14.73 M/Kgs, whilst Russia at 2nd place has witnessed an increase of 5.75% YoY with 13.05 M/Kgs vis-a-vis 12.34 M/Kgs recorded in 2023. The U.A.E with 11.92 M/Kgs (59.01% increase YoY) followed by Türkiye (8.63M/Kgs), Iran (6.29 M/Kgs) and China (5.86 M/Kgs) have been cited as other major importers of Ceylon Tea in the period of January-June 2024.))



SALE OF - 15TH/16TH JULY 2024 (SALE NO. 29)

Fair demand prevailed for the 296,403 packages (19,991,106.00 kilos) on offer with 55.32% unsold.

Pakistan Packers showed useful support with more activity from Egyptian Packers. UK, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries maintained interest while Bazaar and Afghanistan saw reduced enquiry. Kazakhstan, other CIS states and Russia lent more support with Sudan and South Sudan active. Local Packers were less active with Iran absent. Somalia maintained activity at the lower end of the market.

Leaf Grades - 175,344 packages (11,581,070.00 kilos) - 61.00% unsold.

Dust Grades - 91,800 packages (6,879,432.00 kilos) - 51.29% unsold.

Secondary Grades - 29,259 packages (1,530,604.00 kilos) - 33.97% unsold.

Lower Medium - Saw some teas appreciate by up to USC14 while others lost up to USC11.



CTC LEAF: 49,512 packages of teas on offer once again met with a fair demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring Brokens were a fairly good market but were mostly easier in line with quality. Medium and plainer types met with less demand and witnessed more withdrawals. BLF teas met with limited demand with more withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings met with a fairly good demand with prices easing slightly in line with quality. Medium and plainer types met with less demand and witnessed more withdrawals. BLF teas met with limited demand with more withdrawals.

CTC LEAF

DEMAND:

Good Demand at easier price levels.

MARKET

The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 81.87% (1,572,014.57kgs) of the total offering of 1,920,194.87Kgs.

BEST

Modest quantity of larger broken sold at irregular prices. Medium broken sold dearer on quality and competition erratically. Smaller broken prices were irregularly easier except for select invoices at the top end sold firm to dearer. Fanning met with firm to dearer prices especially at the lower end and saw an increase in line with competition.

GOOD:

Limited volume of larger broken on offer sold Rs. 3 easier at the lower end whilst the top end fetched about 8 rupees dearer on competition. Medium broken saw irregular prices. Smaller broken grades sold at barely steady prices. Fanning sold dearer on quality and competition.

RETTER MEDIUM

Larger broken sold easier by Rs. 2 to 3. Medium, smaller broken and fanning at the lower end saw a decline by Rs. 2 to 3 whilst at the top end saw a surge and prices increased substantially.

MEDIUM:

Select larger broken at the lower end sold dearer by Rs. 4 whilst larger volume sold easier by Rs. 3 to 5. Medium broken sold easier by Rs. 3 to 4. Smaller broken sold barely steady to easier.

PLΔINER

Larger broken sold easier by Rs. 2 to 4 remaining grades declined by Rs. 2 to 5.

The Major blenders absorption was at 57.06% of the total CTC leaf sold.

ORTHODOX LEAF

DEMAND:

Fair demand.

MARKET:

The high grown whole leaf sold easier following quality, except for select few invoices which sold dearer on competition. Broken grades too saw a decline in prices following quality. Fanning however, held to last sold prices. Other whole leaf sold barely steady to easier with broken grades seeing a sharp decline in prices. Fanning at the lower end eased whilst the top end held to firm prices.

CTC DUST

DEMAND:

Continued weak demand.

MARKET:

CTC dust offer this week was at 530,787.36Kgs of which 329,809.76kgs were sold (62.14%).

BEST:

All grades saw a sharp decline in prices except for a few odd invoices of the finer dust which sold at steady prices.

GOOD:

PD eased substantially easier whilst, RD sold at barely steady. Finer dust too saw a steep falling away in prices.

BETTER MEDIUM:

All sorts in this category declined by Rs. 4 to 5 or more with larger weight of teas remaining unsold.

MEDIUM:

All sorts sold at easier by Rs. 4 to 5.

PLAINER:

This category of teas sold easier by Rs. 3 to 5, with a larger percentage of teas remaining unsold.

Fair demand at easier prices.

High grown primary sold easier as per quality. The secondary sold easier as per quality. Other category primary dust too saw a decline in prices especially at the top end, secondary dust sold at barely steady to easier prices.
