QUALITY

High and Mid Grown continued to be irregular, whilst the Low Grown were similar to last.

COMMENTS

Total Auction offerings declined to 6.8 M/Kgs. The lowest volume on offer since Sale No. 21 of 1-2 June 2021. There was good demand for the better teas, whilst the others were irregular and often easier.

Ex-Estate offerings comprised of a fairly similar volume to last and totalled 0.95 M/Kgs. A selection of brighter BOPF's in the Best and Below Best categories appreciated in value, whilst the others together with the BOP's were firm and on average, Rs. 20 per kg lower. At the lower end, prices for BOP/BOPF's tend to fluctuate sharply following quality variances. Nuwara Eliyas' were often easier following lower quality, whilst the Uva/Uda Pussellawas' maintained around last week's levels and prices recorded variances often reflective of quality.

High and Mid Grown CTC teas continued to be an area of concern and disappointment with prices remaining unremunerative, perhaps in the backdrop of an oversupply from the African Region.

Low Grown teas comprised 2.8 M/Kgs in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues. Well-made teas continued to attract good demand, whilst the balance were irregular following quality.

Well-made OP1/BOP1's in general were firm, whilst the balance were irregularly easier following quality. A range of better OP/OPA's too sold around last levels, whilst the balance were easier. Better PEK/PEK1's maintained, whilst mixed varieties and poorer sorts declined.

In the Tippy catalogues, Select Best FBOP's were firm to easier, whilst Best and cleaner Below Best appreciated. Balance were firm on last. Well-made FF1's together with cleaner Below Best sold around last levels, whilst the balance were irregular following quality.

In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas continued to attract good demand. Best and cleaner Below Best appreciated, whilst the balance were firm on last levels.

SRI LANKA TEA PRODUCTION - JUNE 2021

January-June 2021 gains 31.03 M/kgs over the corresponding period of 2020

Sri Lanka tea production for the month of June 2021 totalled 25.94 M/kgs, showing a decrease of 1.42 M/kgs vis-à-vis 27.36 M/kgs of June 2020. High and Medium elevations have shown a decline, whilst the Low Grown recorded a marginal gain over the corresponding month of 2020.

January-June 2021 cumulative production totalled 161.49 M/kgs, recording a gain of 31.03 M/kgs vis-à-vis 130.46 M/kgs of January-June 2020. On a cumulative basis, all elevations have shown substantial gains, with the Low Grown in particular gaining 27% over the corresponding period of 2020.

Cumulative production of CTC teas (January-June 2021) totalled 14.04 M/kgs, recording a 2.28 M/kgs increase vis-à-vis 11.76 M/kgs of January-June 2020. Here again, all elevations have shown a significant gain YOY when compared to the corresponding period of 2020 (See more details on Page No. 9).

CROP AND WEATHER

For the period 12 - 18 July 2021

Western/Nuwara Eliya Regions

The Western Region reported bright mornings and scattered evening showers, whilst the Nuwara Eliya Region reported sunny weather throughout the week. The Department of Meteorology expects heavy showers and strong winds in the Nuwara Eliya Region in the week ahead.

Uva/Udapussellawa Regions

The Udupussellawa Region reported clear mornings and overcast evenings, whilst sunny mornings and scattered evening showers were reported in the Uva Region throughout the week.

Low Growns

Bright mornings and sporadic evening showers were reported in the Low Grown Region throughout the week. According to the Department of Meteorology, heavy showers are expected in the Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa regions in the week ahead.

Crop Intake

The Western and Nuwara Eliya regions reported a slight decline in the crop intake, whilst the Uva, Udapussellawa and Low Grown regions maintained.
