QUALITY

Westerns were irregular and barely maintained. A few Nuwara Eliyas continued to be useful, whilst the others together with the Uda Pussellawas were of a fair average quality. Uvas and the Low Growns were similar to last.

COMMENTS

The 8th Sale of the year concluded today had on offer a total of 5.0 M/Kgs, a relatively low volume of tea considering offerings in the preceding years of 2022 and 2021 which recorded auction volumes of 6.0 M/Kgs and 6.1 M/Kgs respectively. There was fair general demand often at irregular rates.

Ex-Estate offerings comprised of 0.74 M/Kgs with the overall quality of teas being barely maintained.

In the backdrop of limited availability, Best Western BOP/BOPF's continued to sell well with select invoices appreciating by up to Rs. 100 per kg and more following special inquiry. Teas in The Below Best category were barely steady and an irregular pattern was observed partially following qualitative variances. Teas at the lower end of the market continued to sell well around last and encountered fairly widespread interest. Nuwara Eliya BOP's which were limited on offer appreciated marginally in value, whilst there were hardly any corresponding BOPF invoices on offer. Uda Pussellawas' were irregular and mostly sold around last. Uva BOP's were firm, whilst the corresponding BOPF's declined up to Rs. 50 per kg.

CTC teas sold around last week's levels, in general, with the Low Grown varieties encountering a slight bearish trend and on average, Rs. 50 per kg easier.

Improved activity from the UK and Japan for the better liquoring teas, whilst there was wider participation for teas in the Below Best and Plainer categories from the Russian sector in addition to some interest from South Africa as well.

Low Growns comprised of 2.3 M/Kgs. Leafy and Semi Leafy catalogues met with fair demand, whilst the Small Leaf varieties continued to decline. Shippers to Iran and Türkiye were selective, whilst shippers to Russia continued to be active.

In the Leafy & Semi Leafy catalogues, a selection of well-made OP1's were firm, whilst the balance were easier. Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom sold around last levels. Select Best BOP1's declined. However, the Below Best and teas at the bottom were firm. A selection of well-made OP/OPA's were firm to selectively dearer, whilst the balance eased. The teas at the bottom appreciated. PEK/PEK1's, in general, were easier.

In the Tippy catalogues, well-made FBOP's were easier, whilst the cleaner Below Best together with cleaner teas at the bottom sold around last levels. Balance were easier. Well-made FF1's were lower, whilst a few cleaner Below Best sold around last levels. The balance too declined.

In the Premium catalogues, a selection of very Tippy teas together with the cleaner Below Best sold around last levels, whilst the balance were irregular.

Nuwara Eliya's - Select invoices gained up to Rs. 100 per kg, whilst the others were irregular. Uda Pussellawa's - Better teas were irregular and easier, whilst the others together with the Uva's were mostly firm.

BOPF

Best Western's - Select invoices gained up to Rs. 100 per kg, whilst the others were irregular and generally firm following quality. Teas in the Below Best category were firm and up to Rs. 50 per kg lower, whilst the Plainer sorts were generally firm. Nuwara Eliya's had hardly any offerings. Uda Pussellawa's - Better teas were easier, whilst the others were firm to marginally dearer. Uva's were firm and up to Rs. 50 per kg lower.

OP/OPA

Well-made OP/OPA's were firm to dearer, whilst teas at the lower end were irregularly dearer.

PEKOE/PEKOE1

A limited selection of Flavory PEK's that were available were irregular. Orthodox leafy PEK/PEK1's in general were easier Rs. 50-100 per kg and more at times. Best Rotavane PEK's were firm. Others were irregular and mostly lower.

FBOP/FBOPF1

A limited selection of Flavory FBOP's that were available were irregular. Well-made Orthodox leafy FBOP/FF1's together with cleaner below best sorts were easier Rs. 50-100 per kg and more at times. Others at the lower end were irregular following quality.

Below Best Dust1's were firm to dearer by Rs. 30-40 per kg, whilst the poorer sorts were firm to dearer by a similar margin. Best Low Grown varieties on offer met with substantially lower demand in comparison with the past few weeks sales. Teas in the Below Best category were firm, whilst the poorer sorts followed a similar trend.

Best High and Medium Grown CTCs were easier by Rs. 20-40 per kg. Below Best varieties and the poorer sorts were marginally dearer by Rs. 30-50 per kg. Best Low Grown CTC's declined by Rs. 70-100 per kg, whilst the Below Best varieties and the poorer sorts were firm to dearer by Rs. 40-60 per kg.

DUST

Cleaner secondaries were mostly firm, whilst the poorer sorts were easier by Rs. 30-50 per kg. Best Low Grown varieties were firm on last week's levels, whilst the poorer sorts declined by Rs. 10-20 per kg.

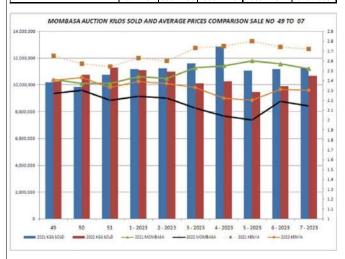
