QUALITY

Westerns together with the Nuwara Eliya's were irregular and barely maintained, whilst the Uva/Uda Pussellawa's together with the Low Grownns were mostly similar to last.

COMMENTS

A total of 6.0 M/Kgs were on offer this week, of which, Ex-Estate offerings comprised of 0.9 M/Kgs. There was good general demand.

Quality of Ex-Estate offerings were barely maintained, whilst there was improved demand. Better Western BOP/BOPF's appreciated Rs. 20-40 per kg and Rs. 20-30 per kg respectively and substantially more for select invoices following special inquiry. Once again, significant price variances were recorded within consecutive invoices of the same estate as buyers followed quality closely. BOP/BOPF's in the Below Best category gained Rs. 10-20 per kg and Rs. 20-30 per kg respectively. At the lower end of the market, BOP's continued to sell around last week's level, whilst the corresponding BOPF's were firm and Rs. 10-20 dearer. The limited availability of Nuwara Eliya BOP/BOPF's were irregular once again following qualitative differences within consecutive invoices. Uda Pussellawa's continued to sell around last week's levels. Uva - select BOP invoices appreciated sharply, whilst the others were irregular following quality. Corresponding BOPF's were firm and up to Rs. 20 per kg dearer.

High and Mid Grown CTC teas met with better demand with prices stabilising around last week's levels, whilst the corresponding Low Grown types and particularly the PF1's declined up to Rs. 20 per kg.

This week's auction witnessed improved activity from shippers to the UK, Japan and China, whilst shippers to the CIS continued to participate actively.

Low Grows comprised of 2.8 M/Kgs in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues. There was fair demand this week.

Select Best and Best OP1/BOP1's were fully firm, whilst the balance were irregular following quality. Better OP/OPA's were firm, whilst the others were easier. However, teas at the bottom end maintained. Well-made PEK/PEK1's appreciated, whilst the balance were firm. Teas at the lower end were easier following quality.

In the Tippy catalogues, FBOP's in general were firm. Select Best FF1's appreciated, whilst the Best were firm on last. Cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom appreciated, whilst the balance were easier following quality.

In the Premium catalogues, Very Tippy teas declined. Few teas in the Best category maintained, whilst the balance were easier. Cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom sold around last levels, whilst the balance were easier following quality.

CTC LEAF: 30,347 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a better demand although prices eased a little.

BROKENS: A few good Brokens on offer were a fairly strong feature of the sale and were mostly firm to a touch dearer whilst other descriptions were about steady on last with a few withdrawals. Plain and BLFs met with fair interest and were a touch easier with some withdrawals.

FANNINGS: There was only a handful of clean Fannings on offer which met with a fairly good demand but the most were a little easier. Medium Fannings were less in demand and were easier with quality. There was also more withdrawals in this category. Plain types witnessed a fair demand but at lower rates and saw some withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 8,014 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring Dusts were easier by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- closely following quality. Mediums were about steady. However, plain and BLF Dusts were fully firm to slightly dearer with less withdrawals compared to last. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: There was a preponderance of plain and end of season teas in this sale and inspite of that there was a fair interest from the Blenders particularly for the cleaner varieties whilst the Loose Tea buyers were also more active especially for the clean teas but at a lower price level. Dusts sold well.
