QUALITY

Continued to show a decline and consequently, a limited availability of good quality teas.

COMMENTS

The 20th Auction for the year which was concluded today comprised of 7.65 M/Kgs. The limited availability of good quality teas met with improved demand. The others, which comprised mainly of fairly average quality teas, met with less demand - a combination of increased availability in this category; a limited number of working days this week on account of the intervening Vesak Poya holidays; in addition to constrained working arrangements following Covid-19 pandemic would also have restricted demand at the auctions.

Ex-Estate offerings totalled approximately 1.2 M/Kgs and comprised of a fairly similar volume to the previous week. A small selection of good teas continued to sell at firm to dearer rates, whilst the others were irregular and mostly easier.

Best Western BOP's - Few select invoices were firm and Rs. 20 per kg dearer, whilst the majority declined Rs. 20-30 per kg and more following quality. The corresponding BOPF's - select high priced teas were easier, whilst the others were irregular. In the Below Best category, better BOP's declined Rs. 20-40 per kg and more, whilst the others together with teas in the Plainer category sold around last week's levels. Corresponding BOPF's in the Below Best and Plainer categories declined Rs. 20-30 per kg and Rs. 10-20 per kg respectively. Nuwara Eliya BOP/BOPF's continued to sell well although at lower levels to last. Uda Pussellawas' were mostly Rs. 10-20 per kg easier. Uva BOP's - better sorts were generally firm, whilst the others were irregular following quality. Corresponding BOPF's - select invoices appreciated Rs. 20 per kg following special inquiry, whilst the others were firm and lower by a similar margin.

High and Mid Grown CTC - BP1 's were Rs. 20-30 per kg lower, whilst the PF1's were Rs. 10-30 per kg lower. Low Grown types - BP1's declined Rs. 20-30 per kg and more, whilst the PF1's were firm and Rs. 10 per kg lower.

Low Growns comprised of 3.3 M/Kgs in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues. There was fair demand for well-made teas, whilst the others met with less interest and were mostly unsellable

Well-made BOP1/OP1's were fully firm to dearer, whilst the others and poorer sorts declined. A selection of better OP/OPA's maintained, whilst the others and poorer sorts declined. Select Best PEK/PEK1's maintained, whilst all others declined substantially and remained mostly unsold due to a lack of suitable bids.

In the Tippy catalogues, well-made FBOP/FF1's were firm, whilst the balance declined following quality.

In the Premium catalogue, very Tippy teas continued to attract good demand. Best too were firm on last, whilst the balance were easier following quality.

SRI LANKA TEA PRODUCTION - APRIL 2021

Production shows signs of recovery with January-April 2021 gaining 29.59 M/kgs over the corresponding period of 2020

Sri Lanka tea production for the month of April 2021 totalled 29.58 M/kgs, showing an increase of 8.76 M/kgs vis-à-vis 20.82 M/kgs of April 2020. All elevations have shown substantial gains, with High and Medium Growns in particular gaining 63% and 76% respectively over the corresponding month of 2020.

January-April 2021 cumulative production totalled 104.09 M/kgs, recording a gain of 29.59 M/kgs vis-à-vis 74.50 M/kgs of January-April 2020. On a cumulative basis also, all elevations have shown substantial gains, with the Low Growns in particular gaining 43% over the corresponding period of 2020.

Cumulative production of CTC teas (January-April 2021) totalled 9.19 M/kgs, recording a 2.17 M/kgs increase vis-à-vis 7.02 M/kgs of January-April 2020. Here Again, when analysing the respective elevations, all elevations have shown a significant gain YOY when compared to the corresponding period of 2020 (See more details on Page No. 9).

Uva's - Select invoices were Rs. 20 per kg dearer following special inquiry, whilst the others were firm and lower by a similar margin.

OP/OPA

Well made OP/OPA's easier Rs. 10-20 per kg whilst others together with the teas at the lower end declined Rs. 20-30 per kg and more at times.

PEKOE/PEKOE1

A limited selection of Flavory PEK's that were available were irregularly dearer. Well made Orthodox leafy PEK/PEK1's easier Rs. 10-20 per kg whilst others were irregularly lower and mostly unsellable. Best Rotovane PEK's were firm to irregularly lower whilst others declined Rs. 10-20 per kg and more.

FBOP/FBOPF1

A limited selection of Flavory FBOP's that were available were dearer. Well made Orthodox FBOP's were easier Rs. 10 - 20 per kg whilst others too were easier by a similar margin. Well made FF1's were firm to marginally easier. Others declined Rs. 10 - 20 per kg.

CROP AND WEATHER

For the period 17 - 23 May 2021

Western/Nuwara Eliya Regions

The Western Region reported dull mornings and evening showers, whilst the Nuwara Eliya Region reported clear mornings at the beginning of the week and dull/rainy weather towards the latter part of the week. According to the Department of Meteorology, heavy showers in the Western Region and strong winds in the Nuwara Eliya Region are expected in the week ahead.

<u>Uva/Udapussellawa Regions</u>

Bright mornings and scattered evening showers were reported from the Udapussellawa Region, whilst the Uva Region reported bright mornings and evening showers throughout the week. The Department of Meteorology expects heavy showers and strong winds in the Uva Region in the week ahead.

Low Growns

The Low Grown Region reported sunny mornings with evening showers throughout the week. According to the Department of Meteorology, heavy showers are expected in the Ruhuna and Sabaragamuwa regions in the week ahead.

All regions maintained the crop intake.

BANGLADESH AUCTION

SALE OF - 24TH MAY 2021 (SALE NO. 03)

CTC LEAF: 20,034 packages of Current Season & 810 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a selective demand with higher withdrawals.

BROKENS: A handful of well made clean liquoring Brokens sold well often easing by Tk. 5/- and more whilst Mediums met with much less demand and prices declined by Tk.7/- to Tk.8/- with heavy withdrawals. Similarly Plain teas also met with only limited interest and there were heavy withdrawals. BLFs saw less interest at lower rates. There were again

more withdrawals in this category.

FANNINGS: A few well made coloury Fannings were well supported at about last levels but Mediums saw selective demand and where sold eased by Tk. 5/- to Tk.7/- but there were heavy withdrawals. Plain teas saw only limited interest and only a few lines sold at reduced levels. BLFs saw less interest at lower rates. There were again more withdrawals in this category

CTC DUST: 6,075 packages of Current Season & 60 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with quite a strong demand. Best and good liquoring Dusts met with a good competition and sold at firm to dearer rates. Other varieties were a steady market. BLF Dusts were readily absorbed at slightly dearer rates with less withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Demand was more selective this week with mostly Blenders operating for coloury teas and neglected lesser varieties. Loose tea buyers were much less active and lent limited support to the best on offer. As a result, withdrawals in the Leaf catalogue was heavier. Dusts witnessed better demand than Leaf and most teas were sold.
