# Quality

A small selection of Westerns showed further improvement, whilst the others together with the Nuwara Eliyas, Uva/Uda Pussellawas and Low Growns showed no change.

#### **COMMENTS**

Auction offerings were fairly similar to last and totalled 4.6 M/Kgs. There was fair demand often at irregular rates.

Ex-Estate offerings too were fairly similar and totalled 0.73 M/Kgs. Overall quality of teas from the Western slopes were irregularly improved, whilst teas from most other regions were fairly similar to last. Prices for the better teas were irregular perhaps to some extent following quality, whilst the encouraging feature was the strong demand for teas at the lower end of the market.

Improved activity from shippers to South Africa. Selective interest from shippers to the UK and the continent, whilst shippers to China and the CIS continued to operate as usual.

Select Best Western BOP's were firm and often up to Rs. 50 per kg easier, whilst the others appreciated by Rs. 50-100 per kg following quality. Corresponding BOPF's - Select invoices appreciated sharply following special inquiry, whilst the others were irregular and easier. In the Below Best category, BOP's sold around last week's levels. Corresponding BOPF's - Improved sorts were firm and dearer, whilst the others were irregular and mostly easier. Plainer BOP/BOPF's sold around last week's levels. Nuwara Eliya BOP's sold around last. Corresponding BOPF's - Select invoices appreciated, whilst the others were difficult of sale. Uva/Uda Pussellawa BOP's sold around last week's levels. Corresponding BOPF's - Uda Pussellawas' were firm and up to Rs. 20 per kg dearer. Uvas'- Select clean leaf teas appreciated by up to Rs. 50 per and more, whilst the poorer sorts declined by a similar margin.

High & Medium Grown CTC teas were mostly firm, whilst the Low Grown varieties particularly the PF1's were marginally easier and more so for the poorer sorts.

A wider selection of improved Westerns' are on offer next week and producers no doubt would eagerly look forward to being adequately compensated.

Low Growns comprised of 2.15 M/Kgs. Leafy and Semi-Leafy categories met with fair demand, whilst the Tippy category met with good demand.

In the Leafy catalogues, few Select Best OP1's appreciated, whilst the balance together with the BOP1's sold around last levels. Select Best OPA's declined, whilst the balance maintained. OP's, in general, appreciated. Well-made PEK/PEK1's were easier, whilst the balance sold around last levels.

In the Tippy catalogues, FBOP's were firm to dearer, whilst the bolder varieties were irregular. Well-made FF1's were firm to dearer, whilst the clean leaf Below Best and clean leaf teas at the bottom appreciated. Balance were firm.

In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas met with good demand and were dearer. Best and Below Best too appreciated, whilst the balance sold around last levels.



Good general demand prevailed for the 315,219 packages (21,108,424.00 kilos) in the market with 45.50% remaining unsold.

Pakistan Packers and Bazaar lent strong support with Egyptian Packers, UK, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries showing more and useful activity. There was more enquiry from Afghanistan and Russia while South Sudan, Kazakhstan and other CIS states reduced interest. Local Packers were more active with Iran and Sudan quiet. Somalia maintained interest at the lower end of the market.

Leaf Grades - 190,400 packages (12,436,980.00 kilos) - 52.31% unsold. Dust Grades - 96,860 packages (7,232,763.00 kilos) - 41.15% unsold. Secondary Grades - 27,959 packages (1,438,681.00 kilos) - 14.24% unsold.

Brighter - Were steady with a few teas irregular varying between USC24 dearer to easier by up to USC18; the older offerings showed improved absorption at lower levels with the lowest price at USC126. 
