QUALITY

High & Mid Growns together with the Low Growns were lower to last.

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COMMENTS

The volume of tea on offer this week totalled 5.7 M/Kgs, sharply lower from the previous week's 6.4 M/Kgs. Better demand particularly as the sale progressed for the Leafy/Low Grown type teas, whilst the High & Medium Small Leaf types continued to be weak.

Ex-Estate offerings were maintained and totalled approximately 1.0 M/Kgs. Once again, weak demand and most teas on offer declined by Rs. 50-100 per kg whilst a substantial volume of tea remained unsold.

The better teas were often lower to a lesser extent and the price declines were steeper particularly for teas in the Below Best and Plainer categories, perhaps as a consequence of a greater availability of offerings comprising of same.

High & Mid Grown CTC teas too were weaker, particularly for the PF1 grade which often eased by Rs. 50-100 per kg and here again, the price declines could be attributed to the increased availability of the Plainer category. Corresponding Low Grown varieties were mostly firm.

Low Growns comprised of 2.1 M/Kgs. Semi-Leafy and Tippy varieties met with good demand, whilst the Leafy varieties were easier.

In the Leafy catalogues, BOP1's in general met with good demand and were dearer, whilst the OP1's were firm to selectively dearer. Select Best OP/OPA's were firm to selectively dearer, whilst the balance sold around last levels. Well-made PEK/PEK1's together with the neater Below Best varieties were selectively dearer, whilst the balance were irregular.

In the Tippy catalogues, select Best FBOP's were firm, whilst the Best and Below Best varieties together with the cleaner teas at the bottom appreciated. Balance were firm. Select Best FF1's were firm to dearer, whilst the balance together with cleaner teas at the bottom appreciated.

In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas together with the Best met with good demand and were firm. Cleaner Below Best sold around last levels, whilst the balance declined. However, the leafier varieties were fully firm.

Nuwara Eliya's were Rs. 20-30 per kg lower. Uda Pussellawa's - Better teas were up to Rs. 100 per kg easier, whilst the others were firm and Rs. 20-30 per kg lower. Uva's - Few select invoices were firm, whilst the others declined up to Rs. 50 per kg.

BOPF

Best Western's - Few select invoices, where quality was maintained, were firm, whilst the others declined up to Rs. 100 per kg and more. In the Below Best category, better teas were up to Rs. 50 per kg easier, whilst the others together with the Plainer sorts declined by Rs. 50-70 per kg. Nuwara Eliya's were mostly unsold. Uda Pussellawa's - Better sorts declined Rs. 100 per kg and more, whilst the others were firm and Rs. 20-30 per kg easier. Uva's were Rs. 50-70 per kg easier.

OP/OPA

Well-made OP/OPA's which commenced firm, gained Rs. 50 per kg and more towards the closure of sale, whilst the others together with teas at the lower end were fully firm to dearer by a similar margin.

PEKOE/PEKOE1

A limited selection of flavoury PEK's that were available were irregularly easier. Orthodox Leafy PEK/PEK1's, in general, were firm to dearer by Rs. 50 per kg and more towards the closure of sale. Rotovane PEK/PEK1's in the Best category met with firm demand, whilst the others declined by Rs. 40-50 per kg and more at times following quality.

FBOP/FBOPF1

A limited selection of flavoury FBOP's that were available were irregularly easier. Well-made Orthodox Leafy FBOP's together with the cleaner Below Best sorts were firm to dearer by Rs. 50-100 per kg, whilst the others at the lower end too followed a similar trend. FF1's, in general, commenced firm on last week's levels and gained Rs. 50-100 per kg as the sale progressed.

Western/Nuwara Eliya Regions
