QUALITY

High and Mid Grown were barely maintained, whilst the Low Grown were similar to last.

COMMENTS

Total auction volumes were significantly lower to the preceding 2 weeks and totalled 4.5 M/Kgs. There was good general demand.

Ex-Estate offerings totalling 0.65 M/Kgs witnessed improved demand and a firm to dearer trend in prices, particularly for the limited selection of useful liquoring teas from the Western Planting Districts. An encouraging feature was the strong demand displayed for teas at the lower end of the market notwithstanding the strengthening of the Sri Lankan Rupee against the US Dollar (lowest rupee value against the USD since 4 May 2022).

High and Medium CTC teas were mostly firm with select invoices appreciating in value, whilst the Low Grown types particularly the PF1's were firm and up to Rs. 50 per kg lower having continued a steady trend over the past several weeks.

Shippers to the UK and Japan were mostly active for the better liquoring teas, whilst shippers to the CIS bid on a wide cross-section of teas in the Below Best and Plainer categories.

Low Grown comprised of 2.0 M/Kgs. Leafy and Semi Leafy catalogues met with fair demand, whilst the Small Leaf categories continued to decline. Shippers to Russia, Iraq and Türkiye were active, whilst shippers to Iran were selective.

In the Leafy & Semi Leafy catalogues, a selection of well-made OP1/BOP1's were firm, whilst the balance were easier. Best and Below Best sold around last levels, whilst teas at the bottom appreciated. Well-made OP/OPA's were firm to marginally easier, whilst teas in the Best and Below Best categories sold around last levels. Teas at the bottom appreciated. Well-made PEK/PEK1's were firm, whilst the Best and Below Best varieties were irregular. Teas at the bottom were firm.

In the Tippy catalogues, a selection of well-made FBOP's were firm, whilst the balance together with the Below Best varieties eased. However, the teas at the bottom sold around last levels. FF1's, in general, were easier.

In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas declined. Best varieties too were marginally easier, whilst the Below Best and teas at the bottom sold around last levels.

CROP AND WEATHER

For the period 20 - 26 February 2023

Western/Nuzwara Eliya Regions

The Western Region reported bright weather, whilst the Nuwara Eliya Region reported occasional clear mornings and chilly evenings throughout the week. The Department of Meteorology expects evening showers in both regions in the week ahead.

Uva/Udapussellawa Region

Rain was reported at the beginning of the week, whilst clear weather conditions were reported towards the latter part of the week in both regions. Heavy showers are expected in the Uva Region in the week ahead according to the Department of Meteorology.

Low Growns

The Low Grown Region reported sunny mornings with sporadic evening showers throughout the week. According to the Department of Meteorology, afternoon/evening showers are expected in the Ruhuma and Sabaragmurwa regions in the week ahead.

Crop Intake

The Western High, Nuwara Eliya and Uva regions maintained. The Udapussellawa Region reported a slight increase in the crop intake, whilst a slight decline was reported in the Low Grown Region.

There was good general demand for the 228,420 packages (15,363,471.00 kilos) available in the market; 32.19% were unsold.

Leaf Grades - 117,400 packages (7,698,167.00 kilos) - 32.37% unsold.
Dust Grades - 84,240 packages (6,308,300.00 kilos) - 38.75% unsold.
Secondary Grades - 26,780 packages (1,357,004.00 kilos) - 10.75% unsold.

MARKETS

Afghanistan showed strong enquiry with useful support from Egyptian Packers. UK, Pakistan Packers, Yemen and other Middle Eastern countries lent more support while Sudan, Russia, Kazakhstan and other CIS states maintained good activity. Iran were quiet with Bazaar subdued. Local Packers were active in line with price. Somalia maintained support at the lower end of the market.

LEAF GRADES (M2)

BPI:

Best - Were well competed for and gained up to USC44 with selected teas advancing by USC52 to USC68.
Brighter - Most lines were steady to USC21 above last levels but some teas shed up to USC24.
Mediums - KTDA mediums were firm to USC18 dearer with only a few invoices easing by up to USC8 while plantation mediums were irregularly dearer by up to USC32.
Lower Mediums - Were irregular varying between steady to USC34 dearer to easier by up to USC26.
Plainer - Ranged between firm to dearer by up to USC16 with select improved invoices advancing by up to USC38 to easier by up to USC14.

PF1:

Best - Advanced by up to USC20.
Brighter - Were firm to dearer by up to USC13.
Mediums - KTDA mediums were steady to USC10 above previous levels while plantation mediums appreciated by up to USC12 but a few invoices eased by up to USC4.
Lower Mediums - Varied between firm to USC18 dearer to USC14 below last rates.

Plainer - Were irregular ranging between mostly dearer by up to USC21 to easier by USC9.

Mediums - Most KTDA mediums were firm to USC5 dearer but some lines lost up to USC9; plantation mediums were irregularly dearer by up to USC20 but some teas shed up to USC4.
Lower Medium - Varied between USC28 dearer to easier by up to USC25.
Plainer - Were irregular and ranged between firm to USC14 dearer to easier by up to USC33.

DUST1:

Best - Ranged between USC24 dearer to easier by up to USC22.
Brighter - Steady to up to USC7 above last prices.
Mediums - KTDA mediums were firm to USC12 easier with a number of lines neglected while plantation mediums appreciated by up to USC20.
Lower Medium - Met more interest and advanced by up to USC42.
Plainer - Varied between steady to USC15 dearer to easier by up to USC22.

BANGLADESH AUCTION

SALE OF - 27TH FEBRUARY 2023 (SALE NO. 43)

CTC LEAF: 28,745 packages of Current Season & 20 packages of New Season teas on offer met with a fair demand at irregularly easier rates.

BROKENS/FANNINGS: There was a nominal weight of clean teas on offer which attracted strong interest and were generally fully firm to occasionally dearer. Lesser varieties met with a selective demand at much easier rates, although the plainest types elicited fair interest at around last levels. BLF teas saw fair interest and were about steady but there were fair withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 7,188 packages of Current Season & 6 packages of New Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand. Good liquoring Dusts sold well at around last levels. Mediums met with a fair demand easing by Tk.15/- to Tk.20/- over last with fair withdrawals. Plain and BLF Dusts were mostly firm on last. Blenders lent good support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Fibrous end of season varieties comprised the bulk of the offerings which met with irregular demand. Blenders operated for clean varieties on offer whilst Loose tea buyers were more active at the lower end of the market. Consequently, lower priced teas met with less withdrawals at about steady rates. Dusts sold well.
