Westerns together with the Nuwara Eliyas were irregular, whilst the Uva/Uda Pussellawas and the Low Growns were similar to last.

COMMENTS

Auction offerings were fairly similar to the previous week and totalled 5.4 M/Kgs. There was fair general demand at firm to easier rates.

Ex-Estate offerings too were fairly similar to last and totalled 0.78 M/Kgs. Overall quality showed a decline, particularly for the seasonal quality Westerns.

Consequently, better Western BOP's declined substantially, whilst the corresponding BOPF's too were mostly Rs. 50-100 per kg easier. In the Below Best category, BOP/BOPF's declined Rs. 20-40 per kg and more as the sale progressed and a similar trend continued for teas at the lower end of the market as well. Nuwara Eliya - Few select BOP's sold well, whilst the others together with the BOPF's were irregular and often tended easier. Uda Pussellawa BOP's declined Rs. 50 per kg and more for the poorer sorts, whilst the corresponding BOPF's sold around last week's levels and often realised prices at the lower end of the market. Uva BOP/BOPF's declined Rs. 50-100 per kg.

High & Medium Grown CTC teas - BP1's had hardly any offerings, whilst the PF1's which commenced firm to marginally easier declined further as the sale progressed with many invoices remaining unsold. Corresponding Low Grown types sold well.

Low Growns comprised 2.2 M/Kgs. Market met with fair demand.

In the Leafy and Semi Leafy catalogues, OP1's in general were firm. A few select Best BOP1's appreciated following special inquiry, whilst the balance were fully firm. Well-made OP/OPA's together with the Below Best maintained, whilst the teas at the bottom were easier following quality. Well-made PEK's together with a selection of bolder varieties sold around last levels, whilst the balance were irregular. PEK1's, in general, were easier. Teas at the bottom declined.

In the Tippy catalogues, select Best FBOP's were irregular, whilst the balance sold around last levels. Select Best FF1's were firm, whilst the Best and Below Best varieties declined. Teas at the bottom sold around last levels

In the Premium catalogues, high priced Tippy teas were easier, whilst the others sold around last levels. However, teas at the bottom declined.

- * National tea sales average for the month of March 2023 recorded Rs. 1,263.00 (USD 3.82), declining Rs. 175.20 from the February 2023 average of Rs. 1,438.20.
- * In comparison to the March 2022 average of Rs. 848.08 (USD 3.35), shows a significant increase of Rs. 414.92and USD 0.47 YOY.

Elevation-Wise Analysis - March 2023:

- * High Grown average for the month of Rs. 1,303.85 (USD 3.94) recorded a decline of Rs. 98.70 month on month vis-à-vis Rs. 1,402.55 (USD 3.86) of February 2023. When compared to the March 2022 average of Rs. 761.39 (USD 3.01), a significant increase of Rs. 542.46 and USD 0.93 is recorded YOY.
- * Medium Grown average of Rs. 1,127.89 (USD 3.41) for March 2023 recorded a decrease of Rs. 129.38 month on month vis-à-vis Rs. 1,257.27 (USD 3.46) of February 2023. When compared to March 2022 average of Rs. 737.88 (USD 2.91), shows an increase of Rs. 390.01 and USD 0.50 YOY.
- * Low Grown average ofRs. 1,282.79 (USD 3.88) in March 2023 recorded a decrease of Rs. 207.20 (USD 0.22) month on month vis-à-vis Rs. 1,489.99 (USD 4.10) of February 2023. When compared to March 2022 average of Rs. 914.02 (USD 3.61), an increase of Rs. 368.77 and USD 0.27 YOY.
- * All elevations record an increase during the period of January-March 2023 when compared to the corresponding period of 2022 both in LKR and USD terms.

HIGH GROWN TEAS

BOP

Best Western's - Select high priced teas were substantially easier, whilst the others declined Rs. 20-40 per kg. Teas in the Below Best category declined Rs. 20-40 per kg and more as the sale progressed, whilst the Plainer sorts were firm and lower to a lesser extent. Nuwara Eliya's - Few select invoices sold well, whilst the others were irregular following quality. Uda Pussellawa's - Better teas declined up to Rs. 50 per kg, whilst the poorer sorts eased further.

Uva's declined Rs. 50-100 per kg.

BOPF

Best Western's - A few select invoices were firm, whilst the others declined Rs. 50-100 per kg. Teas in the Below Best and Plainer categories which declined Rs. 20-40 per kg at the commencement of the sale, eased further as the sale progressed. Nuwara Eliya's had hardly any offerings. Uda Pussellawa's sold around last week's levels with a few price fluctuations reflective of quality. Uva's were up to Rs. 100 per kg easier.

OP/OPA

Well-made OP/OPA's together with lower end were easier Rs. 50 per kg.

PEKOE/PEKOE1

A limited selection of Flavory PEK's that were available were irregular. Well-made Orthodox leafy PEK/PEK1's in general were firm on last, whilst others at the lower end were easier Rs. 50-100 per kg. Best Rotavane PEK's were firm and irregularly lower following quality. Others sold at last levels.

FBOP/FBOPF1

A limited selection of Flavory FBOP's that were available were easier. Well-made Orthodox leafy FBOP/FF1's together with cleaner below best sorts were firm to selectively dearer. Others at the lower end were irregularly easier.

Teas in the Below Best category were mostly firm, whilst the poorer sorts followed a similar trend.

Best High and Medium Grown CTCs were firm to easier by Rs. 20-40 per kg. Below Best varieties and the poorer sorts were mostly firm to dearer by Rs. 20-40 per kg. Low Grown CTC's were irregularly lower by Rs. 50-80 per kg.

DUST

Cleaner secondaries declined by Rs. 60-80 per kg, whilst the poorer sorts were firm to easier by Rs. 20-40 per kg. Best Low Grown varieties declined by Rs. 40-60 per kg except for a few select invoices which gained on special inquiry. The poorer sorts were firm to dearer by Rs. 20-40 per kg.
