QUALITY

Overall, fairly similar to last.

COMMENTS

This week's Auction offerings totalled 6.0 M/Kgs. There was improved demand.

Ex-Estate offerings were fairly similar to last and comprised of 0.7 M/Kgs. Improved demand, particularly for a selection of coloury teas.

Best Western BOP's, particularly the coloury sorts gained Rs. 30-50 per kg, whilst the others were firm and dearer to a lesser extent. Corresponding BOPF's were Rs. 10-20 per kg dearer. In the Below Best category, a selection of improved BOP's gained Rs. 30-50 per kg and substantially more following special inquiry. The corresponding BOPF's - teas in the higher price bracket gained Rs. 20-40 per kg and more, whilst the others were lower by a similar margin. At the lower end of the market, BOP's - clean leaf teas were Rs. 20 per kg dearer, whilst the others were barely steady. Corresponding BOPF's - clean leaf coloury teas were Rs. 10 per kg dearer, whilst the others were barely steady. Nuwara Eliyas' together with the Uda Pussellawas' were barely steady and irregular following quality. Uva - select coloury BOP/BOPF's were firm and up to Rs. 20 per kg dearer, whilst the others and particularly the thinner liquoring teas declined by a similar margin.

High and Mid Grown CTC's - BP1's had hardly any offerings. In the High Grown category, PF1's were firm to dearer, whilst the Medium Grown were irregular and barely steady. Corresponding Low Grown varieties sold well at firm to dearer rates.

Low Grown comprised of 2.6 M/Kgs in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues. Well-made teas together with improved Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom met with good demand, whilst the balance were irregular following quality.

In the Leafy catalogues, Select Best BOP1/OP1's were fully firm to dearer, whilst the others too maintained following quality. A few select Best OP/OPA's maintained, whilst the others and Below Best varieties were mostly easier. Teas at the bottom too were firm to dearer. Select Best PEK/PEK1's, in general, maintained. A range of improved Below Best varieties though irregular were firm, whilst the others and poorer sorts were lower.

In the Tippy catalogues, well-made FBOP/FF1's were firm to selectively dearer, whilst the cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom appreciated. Balance were firm on last.

In the Premium catalogues, Very Tippy teas continued to attract good demand. Best and cleaner Below Best together with cleaner teas at the bottom appreciated, whilst the balance were firm.

SALE OF - 4TH, 5TH & 6TH OCTOBER 2021 (SALE NO. 40)

There was good general demand for the 127,099 packages (8,316,318.50 kilos) available in the market with prices closely following quality. 20.49% were unsold.

LEAF GRADES

Offerings: 65,340 packages (4,221,476.00 kilos) with 20.69% unsold.

Best BP1s in the market met an irregular support ranging between firm to USC6 above last levels following quality to easier by up to USC12 while brighter varieties varied between steady to USC9 dearer following quality to easier by up to USC10. Mediums held firm to USC2 above last week's rates with some invoices remaining without bids while lower medium categories were irregular with quality varying between USC4 to USC6 above previous week's levels to easier by USC3 to USC14 and a few lines were unsold; plainer sorts met an irregular enquiry and ranged between steady to USC13 dearer to easier by USC2 to USC6 with some invoices unsold.

The best PF1s available saw improved interest advancing by USC16 to USC17 while brighter types appreciated by USC4 to USC10 with medium varieties steady to USC26 dearer but some lines remained without bids. Lower medium categories were irregular with quality and ranged between USC3 to USC18 above previous week's rates to easier by USC3 to USC26 and a few invoices remained unsold with plainer varieties ranging between USC2 to USC20 above last prices to easier by USC3 to USC25 and some teas were unsold.

The best PDUSTs on offer saw useful enquiry and gained USC16 to USC20 closely following quality with brighter types USC2 to USC13 above last week's levels while medium varieties were better absorbed at firm to USC16 dearer and a few invoices were unsold. Lower mediums met an irregular interest and improved lines were well-competed for appreciating by up to USC29 but others eased by USC4 to USC10 and a few lines remained unsold. Plainer descriptions were steady to USC18 above last prices but some teas remained without bids.

Best DUST1s in the market were steady to USC7 dearer while brighter types appreciated by USC12 to USC14 closely following quality with mediums better absorbed at firm to USC40 above previous rates but a few lines remained without bids; lower medium varieties were irregular varying between USC4 to USC12 above last prices to easier by USC9 to USC16. Plainer sorts appreciated by USC2 to USC20 with a few invoices easing by up to USC5 and some teas were unsold.



There was strong support from Pakistan Packers and were forceful and dominant with more and strong enquiry from Kazakhstan and other CIS states. Yemen, other Middle Eastern countries, Egyptian Packers and Russia increased interest while Sudan were active. UK and Bazaar reduced activity and were selective. There were some purchases for Iran. Afghanistan were subdued. Local Packers showed good activity on account of price. Somalia were active at the lower end of the market.

CTC LEAF: 49,191 packages of Current Season teas on offer once again met with a fairly strong demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring Brokens continued to be a strong market and were fully firm to slightly dearer. Their Mediums followed a similar trend and mostly sold at around last levels. Plainer varieties were about steady whilst BLF teas were an improved market.

FANNINGS: Good liquoring Fannings were again a good market and sold at little dearer rate. Medium varieties were also a good market and were firm. Plainer sorts were a little easier. BLF teas met with more enquiry and withdrawals were less.

CTC DUST: 12,348 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a good demand. Good liquoring Dusts were fully firm to slightly dearer. Their Mediums were irregular around last. Plain and BLF Dusts were easier by Tk.2/- to Tk.3/- with a few withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Demand was well sustained this week with good liquoring varieties attracting quite useful support. Blenders continued to operate strongly whilst Loose tea buyers also lent a fairly good support which resulted in a little dearer market. Dusts sold well.
