QUALITY

Westerns - Fewer seasonal teas on offer although still continued to be of a useful standard. Nuwara Eliya's comprised of a small selection of seasonal flavoury teas, whilst Uva/Uda Pussellawa's together with the Low Grown's were similar to last.

COMMENTS

Auction offerings were similar to last and totalled 6.5 M/Kgs. Low Grown Large Leaf teas witnessed less demand, whilst the Small Leaf teas together with the High and Medium BOP/BOPF's witnessed good demand.

Ex-Estate offerings comprised of approximately 1.0 M/Kgs. Quality of teas from the Western slopes showed a decline over the previous week with less seasonal teas on offer, although of a useful make. The limited availability of Nuwara Eliya BOP/BOPF's continued to sell at attractive prices, which is indeed encouraging. Teas from the Eastern Sector - BOP's encountered a weak trend, whilst the BOPF's appreciated by a similar margin and more.

High and Mid Grown CTC teas witnessed some recovery from the previous week, although prices compare poorly against their orthodox counterparts. Corresponding Low Grown types continued to sell well in comparison.

A concerning factor would be the limited demand for liquoring seasonal teas from the Western slopes and particularly the Nuwara Eliya District, which were neglected and often remained unsold.

Low Grows comprised of 2.8 M/Kgs in the Leafy/Semi Leafy and Tippy catalogues. There was fair demand at lower levels.

BOP1's in general were lower, whilst well-made OP1's sold around last levels. Balance declined. Well-made OP/OPA's together with PEK/PEK1's were firm, whilst the balance declined substantially.

In the Tippy catalogues, well-made FBOP's were firm to marginally easier, whilst the balance together with bolder varieties declined. However, teas at the bottom were firm on last. Few Select Best FF1's were firm, whilst the balance together with the Best were easier. However, cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom were fully firm, whilst the balance were lower following quality.

In the Premium catalogues, very Tippy teas continued to attract good demand. Best and cleaner Below Best were firm, whilst the others were easier following quality.

NATIONAL TEA SALE AVERAGES - MARCH 2021

National average for the month of March 2021 totalled Rs. 654.32 (USD 3.35) vis-à-vis Rs. 645.95 (USD 3.35) of February 2021, showing a marginal increase of Rs. 08.37 month on month. However, in comparison to March 2020 average of Rs. 595.22 (USD 3.26), shows a fairly significant increase of Rs. 59.10 (USD 0.09) YOY.

In analysing the respective elevational averages - High Grows, totalling Rs. 631.30 (USD 3.23) for March 2021, have recorded an increase of Rs. 19.47 month on month vis-à-vis Rs. 611.83 (USD 3.17) of February 2021. However, when compared to the March 2020 average of Rs. 560.10 (USD 3.06), a fairly significant increase of Rs. 71.20 is recorded YOY. Mediums, averaging Rs. 599.11 (USD 3.06) for March 2021, have recorded an increase of Rs. 19.33 vis-à-vis Rs. 579.78 (USD 3.01) of February 2021. In comparison to the March 2020 average of Rs. 540.07 (USD 2.95), shows an increase of Rs. 59.04 YOY. Low Grows, totalling Rs. 676.30 (USD 3.46) for March 2021, recorded a marginal increase of Rs. 02.19 vis-à-vis Rs. 674.11 (USD 3.50) of February 2021. Here again, the average shows a significant increase of Rs. 50.52 YOY when compared to Rs. 625.78 (USD 3.42) of March 2020.

The January-March 2021 cumulative national average of Rs. 648.63 (USD 3.37), records an increase of Rs. 53.82 (USD 0.08) vis-à-vis Rs. 594.81 (USD 3.29) of January-March 2020.

High Grows for the period January-March 2021 of Rs. 619.22 (USD 3.21) have shown an increase of Rs. 65.03 vis-à-vis Rs. 554.19 (USD 3.07) of January-March 2020. Mediums averaging Rs. 588.49 (USD 3.05) have shown an increase of Rs. 67.67 vis-à-vis Rs. 520.82 (USD 2.88) of January-March 2020. Meanwhile, Low Grows totalling Rs. 674.50 (USD 3.50) for January-March 2021 have shown the lowest increase of Rs. 46.14 vis-à-vis Rs. 628.36 (USD 3.48) of January-March 2020. Nuwara Eliya's continued to sell well, although prices were irregular. Uva/Uda Pussellawa's were Rs. 20-40 per kg dearer.
OP/OPA	Well made OP/OPA's were easier Rs. 20-30 per kg and more at times whilst others too were irregularly easier.
PEKOE/PEKOE1	A limited selection of Flavory PEK's that were available declined substantially and mostly unsellable. Well made Orthodox leafy PEK/PEK1's declined sharply whilst others too were easier Rs. 20-30 per kg and more at times. Rotovane PEK's were firm to marginally dearer.
FBOP/FBOPF1	A limited selection of Flavory FBOP's that were available were irregular whilst few improved invoices were dearer. Well made Orthodox FBOP's were easier Rs. 20 - 40 per kg and more at times whilst others were easier Rs. 10-20 per kg. Well made FF1's were easier Rs. 10 - 20 per kg whilst others too were irregularly easier.

A few select Best OPAs were fully firm to dearer. A selection of cleaner Below Best varieties maintained while others were easier. Teas at the bottom end maintained.

Select Best PEK/PEK1s together with a range of bold PEKs maintained, while others and poorer sorts declined substantially.

BOPF

Well-made BOPF were easier. Balance sold around last levels.

FBOPF/FBOPF1

Very Tippy teas continue to attract good demand. Best and cleaner Below Best were firm. Others irregular following quality. Few select Best FF1s sold around last levels. Balance together with Best declined. However, Cleaner Below Best and cleaner teas at the bottom were firm. Others were lower following quality.
